[(e) *Unique Procurement Instrument Identifier (PIID)*. The FPDS requires that each reporting agency assign a unique contract, order, or call number (procurement instrument identifier) for each contract, order, BOA, Basic Agreement, BPA and BPA call reported to FPDS. Agencies are required to have in place, no later than October 1, 2003, a system that will ensure that each PIID reported to FPDS is unique, Government-wide, and will remain so for at least 20 years from the date of contract award. To eliminate the possibility of duplication between agencies, agencies must submit their proposed plan to the Federal Procurement Data Center, which will provide a record of registration.]
